CATTARAUGUS WESLEYAN INDIAN CHAPEL

Since '08, we have traveled for our annual WW district gatherings ('08- Buffalo's Westside; '09 - Jamestown's Gateway Center). This year, July 24, we were graciously hosted by Dan and Martha Duda, and the church family at Cattaraugus Indian Chapel in Irving NY. Established 43 years ago, in 1987 (23 years ago), the Lord led Dan and Martha to serve as its pastoral family. While first under the Native American Ministries of the Wesleyan Church, the chapel is now under our WNY district. Perhaps a little known fact is that Dan and Martha serve there as missionaries - their salary comes from support raised, as do other Global Partner missionaries.

While preparing for our annual gathering, the WW leadership team felt strongly we would like to invite western NY WW groups/churches to partner with Cattaraugus Indian Chapel during this coming year. This came as a surprise to Martha - the idea



was completely the initiative of the rest of the leadership team. Your support of the District Project for 2009-2010 was fantastic! - 22 churches worked together to give over \$17,000 toward support of the Hope Refugee Sewing Center. We hope your support there will continue, but we invite you to open your heart

to this new ministry opportunity as well.

CHAPEL PROJECTS

Install interior and exterior doors (on hand) and apply finish (varnish, etc.) to door surfaces. - some done

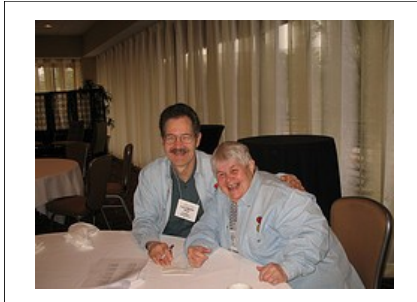
for painting - 3/4 scraped, primed, painted.

Repair sanctuary ceiling - Not done

Outside walls of church need power washing in preparation

Paint interior and exterior walls of church - exterior 3/4 done .

Replace translucent panels in cross-shaped window at front of sanctuary - Not done

Install ceiling tiles (on hand) in church basement to replace damaged tiles (12" X 12") - not done.

Cut & Split firewood on hand in parsonage yard - started.

Enclose rear, exterior corner of church as mower storage shed - Not done
